Talula Restaurant & Bar, which opened in the heart of Miami Beach's arts district in June 2003, and is owned and operated by husband and wife culinary team, Frank Randazzo and Andrea Curto-Randazzo, are announcing the close of Talula.

Their South Beach location has been sold making way for Eden Restaurant - expected to open in October 2010 after a short renovation. Chefs Andrea & Frank are heading the food and kitchen operations at the newly opened The Water Club in North Miami Beach. Chef Andrea Curto-Randazzo just competed in the current season of Top Chef. Future plans for more restaurant projects are in development, however no new opening is expected until 2011 as the Randazzo's will enjoy some family time with their three small girls and current operations.

"We have been fortunate to have had many years of success with Talula but this location is very ready for a new concept" says Frank. "Our future restaurant plans are in the works here in Miami and maybe even in New York too....more to come." says Andrea. "We have a lot of pans on the stove- it's a nice position to be in, and we plan on enjoying a less hectic schedule for now."
